# Payroll version 6.0B

## PAYROLL VERSION 6.0B

TIS Software Ltd is pleased to announce the availability of Payroll version 6.0B.

We had hoped to start the generation process on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May; if we had achieved this, we would be mailing the 3-day-turnaround orders on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May. However we can not achieve this date because 'final' testing threw up a number of problems which are being fixed now. We are sorry for the delay in distribution; we believe that the time spent testing the software now will lead to fewer problems when you talk the users through using the software. The likely timescale is as follows:-

- Full regression testing should be complete during Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May.
- Generation should start on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> and all orders received by Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> May should be complete by late-afternoon on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup>.
- The generated orders should be put into a distribution operation during Saturday. Distribution will be by Royal Mail, Red Star, Parcelforce or any other courier company; the decision on how to distribute the software will be made on what will be the quickest and most reliable method. Any charges for one-day turnaround and couriers for Payroll will be waived.

Version 6.0B must be used from the first Payroll on or after 18<sup>th</sup> May 1992 (for changes to NI and tax). Other changes are the introduction of Class 1A NICs in June.

Two new pieces of documentation are available:-

- Payroll version 6.0B release notice (MPRRV6.0B)
- Notes on Payroll version 6.0B (MPRNV6.0B)

Payroll version 6.0A will no longer be available from 31<sup>st</sup> May 1992 and will not be supported from that date. **ALL users of Payroll must upgrade to version 6.0B.** There will be no upgrade from 6.0A to any 1993 versions of Payroll, nor will any programs to convert 6.0A data to 6.0B be produced except as part of 6.0B. We strongly advise that resellers place orders for all their Payroll users immediately so as to avoid the traditionally hectic few weeks in our software production department which start in mid-May.

The default version of Payroll becomes 6.0B with immediate effect.

## PAYROLL TAILORING VERSION 6.0B

A new version of Payroll tailoring (V6.0B) will be available from Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 1992. Version 6.0A of Payroll tailoring will no longer be available from 31<sup>st</sup> May 1992. The default version of Payroll Tailoring becomes 6.0B with immediate effect.

One new piece of documentation is available:-

- Payroll Tailoring notes version 6.0B (MYRNV6.0B)

## PAYROLL AUTOPOSTINGS

There is no new version of Autopostings; version 6.0A will operate with version 6.0B of Payroll.

## BACS

There is no new version of BACS; version 6.0A will operate with version 6.0B of Payroll. We are taking this opportunity to change the default version of BACS from 6.0 to 6.0A.
