Support for Obsolete Modules and Versions

DROPPING MODULES AND VERSIONS

Every couple of years we look at the range of modules and versions which we currently sell and support and consider which have been superseded. This bulletin is formal notification of our intentions to drop items from our range of software for sale and support.

'No longer for sale' means we cannot guarantee to supply the module/version in question nor the associated documentation. In some cases we are able to supply software after the 'no longer available for sale' date, but usually no documentation is available and the software may be supplied on unusual diskette formats; there is a £50 excess charge for such generations of obsolete software.

'Supported until', we mean that we cannot guarantee to support the module/version in question after the date specified. We will do our best to help resellers with obsolete modules and versions and will support other modules at the site fully (unless their problems are associated with the obsolete item).

REMINDER ABOUT PREVIOUS ANNOUNCEMENTS WHICH TAKE EFFECT NOW

On 25th July default versions of various modules change. The default version of PC Workstation becomes 7.0. The default version of Speedbase Development becomes 3.1. The default version of Purchase Ledger (and its autoposting and tailoring modules) become 7.0. The default version of System Manager becomes 7.0. The default version of Job Costing becomes 1.3C. Please note that the Ledger Pack's constituent parts will change because of the change to the default version of Purchase Ledger and System Manager.

On 31st July version 6.2 of System Manager (and associated modules) ceases to be available.
