

Handbook Issue 11 available

Issue 11 of the Global reseller handbook is now available. Two copies for use by your company are enclosed.

The purpose of the handbook is to hold information accurately and clearly so that our customers and our staff can answer questions on policy, availability and prices to whatever detail is required. Chapter 3 (Configurations) no longer includes the now-obsolete version 6.2 configurations. The support level of the configuration 5523 (the Sun SPARC on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**) has changed (for the worse). The table of terminals supported starting on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.** now includes details of Speedbase TAPs distributed with version 4.0 of the Global 3000 Distribution Suite. The list of VAX computers supported (page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**) has been added to.

Chapter 4 (Service) has had the zaps section enhanced: the introduction to what a zap is on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.** is clearer (we hope); the timetable on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.** updated; a description of how to run autozaps has been added on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**; a description of the zap enquiry program has been added at page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**. A new section on Speedbase Development Advice has been added at page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**. The compulsory nature of Global 3000 Service is noted at page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**. The procedures for renewal of service are explained on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**.

In the Training chapter (chapter 5), all references to the Leicester and Glasgow training centres have been removed. Two new course are described:

- Tailored Global 3000 end-user courses (page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**)
- Hardware (page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**)

The new training timetable has been added starting at page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**.

The major change to the hardware section (chapter 6) is the inclusion of the new Foundation range of computers on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**.

The Documentation section (chapter 7) includes all the new documents associated with the new modules and versions in chapter 2. Furthermore a new API (ABAV8.0U0 – Speedbase Presentation Manager and Development System version 8.0) is included on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.**.
