System Manager for MS-DOS on MS-DOS version 6

We have certified Global System Manager version 7.0 and 8.0 for use on Microsoft MS-DOS version 6 but the following problems may be encountered if the DoubleSpace disk compression facility is used:-

1. The integrated (DOS-FILE) and discrete (SSD-FILE) data file controllers do not report errors when the disk has been filled. This means that data can be lost without System Manager reporting any problems, e.g. when copying files using \$F no errors will be reported if MS-DOS is unable to store the data. (The cause of this problem is being investigated.)
2. The BIOSFILE controller will not work at all on compressed disks. It is reported as a missing device when System Manager is loaded.
