Re-release of \$TAPE V7.0A

This bulletin is to announce a major repackaging of \$TAPE V7.0A. The repackaging includes the following features:-

- The bug that resulted in a computer hanging after the use of \$TAPE has been fixed;
- \$TAPE now functions correctly on non-file servers which have system id's higher than 0x1f. This is particularly important when running \$TAPE on System Manager (Unix);
- Two new \$TAPE controllers have been added for use with System Manager (BOS) which produce tapes with a format identical to that produced when \$TAPE is used with System Manager (Unix). The addition of these new controllers, for use with SCSI QIC and SCSI Exabyte drives, allows data to be transferred from System Manager (BOS) to System Manager (Unix) computers more easily than the current technique. See section I.3 of the V7.0A \$TAPE manual.

The new controllers also allow the transfer of data from System Manager (Unix) to System Manager (BOS) computers.
