

Version 4.2 of Global 3000 - further availability

This bulletin is supplementary to bulletin GT653 dated 15 February 1994 which announced the availability of the core of version 4.2 of the Global 3000 applications. This bulletin makes some announcements which were omitted from that bulletin, mainly because the software involved had yet to pass quality control.

The following are available as from today:

- **Upgrade from Global 2000 to version 4.2 of Global 3000.** The operation of this is as described in GT653. The four upgrade source modules and their documentation are available from today. The Creditors and Debtors upgrade programs which have been distributed (but unannounced) passed quality control unscathed; the Stock Control and General Ledger upgrades have been amended since 15th February and therefore care must be taken to use the new programs distributed from today. The next paragraph explains the details. These program files will be available via autozaps.

The following upgrade program files have superseded the program files distributed before today:

- **Global 3000 Intrastat.** The operation of this is as described in GT653. The Intrastat module and its documentation is available from today.
- **The Interface between Global 3000 General Ledger version 4.2 and Global Payroll version 6.1.** This interface has now been tested; no changes were necessary to the software distributed on the Product Maintenance diskettes since 15th February. However, a new piece of documentation describing this interface is available as from today. This document (MZGOV4.2) is entitled Global 3000 General Ledger Notes (II) – Interfacing to Global Payroll version 6.1.
- **The Interface between Global 3000 Creditors Ledger version 4.2 and Global BACS version 6.1.** The availability of this interface was inadvertently omitted from the API, quality control process and therefore bulletin GT653. This interface, as described in the Creditors Ledger manual, is available from today.

Global 3000 Recovery is still undergoing development work and therefore cannot be released today.

The prices of the modules are as described on page 3 of GT653.

The documentation available is as described on page 4 of GT653 with the exception that the notes describing the interface between General Ledger and Payroll are available. Anyone who has received General Ledger before today will need to order the document describing the interface between General Ledger and Payroll explicitly (it is free of charge). The notes describing the upgrade from Global 2000 which, from today, will be distributed with Stock Control and the three ledgers have been placed on back order for orders prior to today. Back orders will be satisfied over the next few days.

The interfaces between modules are as described on pages 5 and 6 of GT653 with the addition that Creditors Ledger interfaces to version 6.1 of Global BACS.
