## **Error in File Converter documentation for MSDOS file converter**

Appendix C of both the V7.0 and V8.0 Global File Converters manuals (Customising a standard file converter) contains several errors in the table that refers to customising the MSDOS file converter. All values in the "last cluster on the disk" row are wrong. The correct values should be:

	<b>C10</b>	<b>C24</b>	<b>G1</b>	<b>B3</b>	<b>O2</b>
Last cluster on the disk	317	356	2373	715	2849

The documented values for all the other parameters (e.g. "Starting sector of FAT #1", "Sectors per cluster") are correct.

The error will only cause a problem if an attempt is made to use FCONV/MSDOS on an MS-DOS diskette that contains data on the last two clusters of the media.
