## **Global Windows Workstation V1.2 now available**

### **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin is to announce the release of version 1.2 of the Global Windows Workstation (formerly known as the Windows GUI option). This is the first generally available release of this software (the earlier versions 1.1 and 1.1c were released for evaluation purposes only).

**Important Note:** The Global Windows Workstation will only operate with Global System Manager V8.1 or later.

### **DETAILS OF FEATURES**

The Global Windows Workstation is a Windows program that controls the screen on a PC running Global System Manager (MS-DOS) or Global System

Manager (Novell NetWare). The workstation software translates the screens of Speedbase programs into Microsoft Windows presentation standards and allows the use of the mouse.
