## **Global System Manager (Unix) for AIX V4.1**

We are pleased to announce the release of Global System Manager (Unix) V8.0 for AIX V4.1 on the Motorola Power PC and IBM RS/6000. Outline configuration details are as follows:-

- Global System Manager is a Unix application: all peripheral devices (e.g. printers) are accessed via Unix. The Unix systems file determines the run-time configuration.
- Global System Manager runs as a standard AIX V4.1 application.
- Tape backup is performed from within the Unix operating system using the standard utilities provided although \$TAPE is supported on AIX V4.1.
- Systems for configuration 5554 are distributed on QIC tape (both Global and non-Global format files).
- Systems for configuration 5557 are distributed on DAT tape (both Global and non-Global format files).
- This is a LAN system (as are all V8.0 Unix systems) and pricing is therefore LAN pricing. Configurations are available for price codes X to G inclusive (4 to 99 screens inclusive) and also for price code Z (9999 screens). All configurations require the XL System Manager or ML System Manager PM.
- The option to hold C-ISAM format Speedbase databases is NOT available for this configuration.
- We do not have a computer permanently at the London Development and Support Centre. We rely upon you, the reseller, reproducing problems on your computer. When we investigate problems, we have two alternatives:-
  - We access your computer via a modem (not possible for all types of problems); or
  - We visit the site at a mutually convenient time; such a visit would be chargeable.

Configuration notes C5554 or C5557 should be ordered for more detailed

information on the exact configuration.
