## **Global File Converters version 8.1 now available**

Global Business Systems is pleased to announce the availability of Global File Converters version 8.1. Global File Converters version 8.1 will only operate with version 8.1 of Global System Manager.

In addition to the facilities offered by version 8.0 Global File Converters, version 8.1 of this product includes the following new features:–

Global File Converters version 8.1 will only run with version 8.1 or later Global System Manager.

- The SVC–61 based MS–DOS FILECONV utility has been enhanced to include a new conversion type that allows report files (type RS) to be imported and exported. A \$F–style file selection option has been added;
- Two new conversion types that copy any type of Global System Manager file (including directory information) are now available. These conversion types allow utilities to be copied intact using DOS or Unix utilities (e.g. Comms packages) from one Global System Manager environment to another;
- The PSAM based MS–DOS Native Interface Program has been enhanced to operate on disks (and diskettes) with 16–bit FAT tables. Earlier versions expected 12–bit FAT tables;
- Many more MS–DOS functions are now supported by SVC–61:–

- The C-ISAM UCI for Global System Manager (Unix) now supports several new functions;
- A Btrieve UCI for Global System Manager (DOS, Windows and Novell) is now available;
- The serialisation problem within the File Converter installation job has been fixed;
- The Global System Manager (Unix) file converter, FCONV-C2, has been modified to use Unix "file i/o" operations rather than Unix "stream i/o" operations.
