## **Autozap run 7065**

This is a six monthly run of autozaps which contains all zaps since run 7059.

Due to the number of repackaged components included on the run, the autozap run has been split. Resellers and end users with Global System Manager related products and/or Global 2000 products only have received a copy of the autozap run excluding all Global 3000 application repackages. Resellers and end users with Global 3000 applications have received the entire run.

A copy of Autozap Enquiry is also distributed with this run.

Several recovery programs are included on the autozap diskette.

## **AUTOZAPS**

Please note that this autozap run contains zaps for V4.2E and V4.2F of the Global 3000 enhancement stream. It is recommended that the Global 3000 zaps are created on a module by module basis to avoid the possibility of updating the Global 3000 V4.2 program libraries with programs for a later version of the software.

The menu file for Global 3000 Creditors Ledger V4.2, CL-Menus, has been repackaged as zap ZP-4.2B-40. It is a password-protected file and needs to be copied onto the Creditors Ledger data unit using \$F and renamed from ZP4B4001 back to CL-Menus.

## **GLOBAL 2000 ENHANCEMENTS**

This autozap run contains zap BF1027 which allows Global Finder V1.0 to handle date keys correctly where the dates stored are after 31/12/99. Please note this zap will only work if Global Finder is run on GSM V7.0 or later. If Global Finder is run on an earlier version of GSM a PGM CHK will occur.

An enhancement to the Uninvoiced Deliveries report in Purchase Order Manager V7.1 has been introduced as zap PM7152. It is now possible to print uninvoiced deliveries up to a user specified cut-off date.

## **GLOBAL 3000 ENHANCEMENTS**

Two enhancements to Sales Order Processing V4.2 have been issued as zaps on this autozap run.

Zap ZS-4.2B-32 allows services and extras to be printed on delivery notes. It must be applied in conjunction with zap ZM-4.2-48 which updates Product Maintenance to allow the service and extra products to be specifically selected for inclusion on delivery notes.

Zap ZS-4.2B-51 enhances Automatic Allocation. Functionality performed by Automatic Allocation has been split into three separate phases which may be run individually or combined. The three phases are credit checking, release of repeating orders and allocation (including the release of forward orders).

This autozap run also introduces two enhancements to Purchase Order Processing V4.2F (the current enhancement stream release).

Zap ZO-4.2F-05 allows the entry of extras at Invoice Input with a negative value to handle returns.

Zap ZO-4.2F-06 introduces the handling of oncosts at Goods Receipt. An oncost percentage can be set up at product group, product code or supplier/product level and is applied to the value of the receipts, net of discount, and posted to the cost variance account in General Ledger. Zap ZM-4.2F-06 must be applied in conjunction with zap ZO-4.2F-06.

## **GLOBAL 3000 SOURCES**

The source code master diskettes for the Global 3000 V4.2 applications have recently been revised to include only the most recent version of each source. This will continue on a monthly basis in line with Autozaps.
