Global Business Systems is pleased to announce the availability of Global System Manager V8.1 revision g and Global System Manager for Windows NT. Global System Manager (Windows NT) operates on Windows NT Server, Windows NT Workstation, Windows 95 and standalone Windows NT configurations.

We are awaiting the return of the manuals from the printers, but generation of software starts today so that orders may be despatched as soon as the manuals become available. There are a number of orders already on back order and all orders will be processed on a first come first served basis. Please do not submit orders on a 24 hour turnaround as we will not be able to supply in this timescale.

GLOBAL SYSTEM MANAGER (WINDOWS NT)

Global System Manager (Windows NT) is a full 32-bit Client-Server release of Global System Manager and does not suffer from any of the restrictions of the essentially 16-bit Global System Manager (MS-DOS) implementation.

This release of Global System Manager (Windows NT) only supports Global filing systems. Support of Btrieve and SQL for Speedbase products databases is scheduled for release later this year.

To order Global System Manager (Windows NT), please use new configuration code 5661 (Windows NT (Intel), Windows 95; 3.5" diskette).

The Configuration Notes give full details of configurations and hardware platforms supported by Global System Manager. Note that Global System Manager (Windows NT) is not available for any non-Intel platforms (e.g. PowerPC, Dec Alpha, MIPS).

GLOBAL SYSTEM MANAGER V8.1 revision g

Global System Manager (Windows NT) is released as part of Global System Manager and Global System Manager (PM) V8.1 revision g.

The main features of this release are:-

- Improvements to several Global System Manager utilities and System Requests;
- Support for 132-wide mode in all the standard Global Windows Workstation (GUI) TAP's;
- Minor improvements to GSM installation;
- Improvements to the Global Cobol Development System;
- Minor improvements to the Global Speedbase Development System;
- Minor improvements to Global Configurator.

Global System Manager V8.1 revision g is fully described in the Global System Manager V8.1 Notes (document MSMNV8.1). This document can be ordered from the Production Department and is available on the BBS.

PRICING

Pricing for Global System Manager (Windows NT) is fully documented in Sales Bulletin GS141. Free of charge generations are not available for Beta Test sites.

Global System Manager V8.1 revision g is available free of charge for all users on service who are upgrading from Global System Manager V8.1 of the same level and family (any revision).
