\$TAPE now supported on Global System Manager (Windows NT)

This bulletin announces the release of \$TAPE V7.1. \$TAPE V7.1 includes the following new features:-

- Support for Global System Manager (Windows NT) configurations. Please refer to the Global System Manager (Windows NT) Configuration Notes for further details;
- Support for the AHA-1510B card – the zap described in Global Technical Bulletin GT822 (10 December 1996) is no longer required;
- A fix for the problem that results in the following fatal error message:-

Exception from RESID\$

This problem frequently occurs on configurations that include a small number of Memory Banks. The problem is overcome in \$TAPE V7.1 by obtaining exclusive control (using GETX\$) if the attempt to make the Memory Bank permanently resident (RESID\$) fails because of insufficient free memory banks.

Note that the fix for this problem is also available for existing users of \$TAPE V7.0A (via Autozaps).

\$TAPE V7.1 is available for a copy charge to all users of \$TAPE who are on service.

Existing users who are upgrading to \$TAPE V7.1 should be aware that all the \$TAPE customisations are held in the P.\$TAPE file and will be lost when the new library is installed. Any customisations must be re-applied after installation.
