Global System Manager (Windows NT) now available on CD

In a move to provide a more reliable and industry standard software distribution method, Global Business Systems is pleased to announce the availability of Global System Manager (Windows NT) on CD.

Those resellers who are familiar with Global System Manager (Unix) distribution tapes will recognise the contents of a Global System Manager (Windows NT). In addition to the various "BACNAT files" a GSM260 domain directory contains the various Global System Manager distribution sub-volumes (i.e. BACRES, BEA, HAA, (optionally) EPA and CFA) and all the relevant Global product sub-volumes (e.g. FCA, ZDA etc.). The contents of the CD are copied to a "post-box" area on the hard disk. Global System Manager and the Global products are installed using the normal techniques from the "post-box" area.
