## **Autozap run 7091**

This is a three monthly run of Autozaps which contains all zaps since run 7088.

Due to the size of the Autozap run, reseller copies only have been distributed for this run. ### **GLOBAL 2000 ENHANCEMENTS**

Zaps BF-1.0-35, BG-1.0-21, BW-6.0A-41, NP-6.1-10 and OZ-6.1-19 relate to changes made for Year 2000 compliance.

### **GLOBAL 3000 ENHANCEMENTS**

Zaps ZD-4.4-41, ZS-4.4-69, ZS-4.4-70 and ZS-4.4-73 introduce a new option whereby the Automatic delivery charge product specified on a customer basis can be set up as either a new order line or as a trailer comment.

Zaps ZD-4.5-02, ZS-4.5-3, ZS-4.5-04 and ZS-4.5-05 introduce the above feature in Global 3000 V4.5 applications.

Zaps ZM-4.4-35 and ZS-4.4-74 introduce a new system parameter to govern how stock is handled during Automatic Allocation if there is insufficient stock to cover an order.

Zaps ZM-4.5-07, ZS-4.5-12 and ZS-4.5-13 introduce the above feature in Global 3000 V4.5 applications.

Zap ZP-4.5-06 introduces a new option in the Open Items Report. The report can now be printed in transaction date or transaction type within currency.

Zap ZS-4.3M-39 amends the Reporter extract file for Picking List print to include order specific details to be incorporated on tailored prints.

Zap ZX-4.4-02 introduces the option to create SSD reports to send to Customs and Excise via electronic submission.

Zap ZX-4.5-01 introduces the option to create SSD reports to send to Customs and Excise via electronic submission.
