## Millennium Compliance and Sales Analysis.

### SA003

We have recently discovered a Y2K compliance problem, with the SA003 Data Maintenance program used by the majority of Sales Analysis users.

The problem is that when the data maintenance program SA003 is used to amend a date after 31/12/1999 it changes the century back to 1900.

E.G. 01/01/2000 becomes 01/01/1900, 01/01/2001 becomes 01/01/1901 etc.

This problem will be found when using "Report generator". The Period-End date will not default to the correct date at the "SELECT COLUMN LAYOUT AND SECONDARY SORT" screen, and reports generated will not hold valid information.

### RECOVERY PROGRAM

There is a recovery program for versions 4.4 and 4.5, which has been created to correct data which is already demonstrating this problem, called "ZTRECI" and this can be found on both the BBS and the Web-Site.

The new Y2K compliant version SA003 is now available from the BBS and Web-Site, and you will also find SAPRIN, which is a report-only version of SA003.

The new version of SA003 and the new programs 'ZTRECI' and 'SAPRIN' will also run on Global 2000 Sales Analysis V6.4 databases.
