Payroll V6.6 update

With Payroll V6.6 now out in the field, and feedback received from an IMIS test that is currently in progress, a number of issues have been reported. This bulletin details these issues and the corresponding fixes where appropriate.

- Program PR290 (Close Period) required a 54Kb user area. This may result in a "PR290 TOO LARGE" error message. Payroll V6.6 zap 3 (PR6603) repackages Close Period so that it can be run with a user area of 50Kb. As a result of this problem the rest of Payroll V6.6 has been checked and it has been found that PR140 (Cumulative Adjustments) and PR243 (Create NL Posting File) both require slightly over 50Kb (51486 bytes & 51806 bytes respectively). As these are only fractionally over 50Kb these have not been repackaged.
- In some cases a STOP 201 can occur when printing the Gross Pay Analysis report. This has also been fixed by Payroll V6.6 zap 3 (PR6603).
- Zaps have been produced for both Payroll Autopostings (YX6601) and Payroll Tailoring Kit (YR6601) to incorporate the changes resulting from the above repackages.
- The Payroll manual supplied with orders shipped before 21st March 2000 is missing 50 pages (101-150). These missing pages will be despatched as soon as we receive them from our printers.

All zaps and repackages are available from our web site www.global3000.com as are full details of Payroll V6.6. In addition an update summarising the effect of today's budget on Payroll will be published on the web site as soon as we have analysed the details.
