Payroll V6.6 and the Menu Handler

For versions of Payroll prior to V6.6 we advised that the "Run in text mode" flag in the line on the system menu (e.g. \$\$MENUS) that runs the PR program should be set to Y. This option was required to allow the "Global 2000 style" Payroll application to operate correctly when used with either the Global Windows Workstation (GUI) or the GSM (Windows NT) client in conjunction with a GUI terminal code (e.g. 711, 714 etc.).

However, a side effect of enabling the "Run in text mode" option on the high-level system menu (e.g. \$\$MENUS) is that the Payroll application menus appear in a non-GUI, text-only style.

For Payroll V6.6 this issue has been fully resolved by setting the "Run in text mode" flag to Y in all the menu lines in the PR-Menus application menu. Zap BS8K18 must be applied for this facility to operate successfully. Consequently, there is no requirement to set the "Run in text mode" flag to Y in the system menu line that initiates Payroll V6.6.
