GSM (Unix) Configurations

This bulletin announces some important changes to the distribution of GSM (Unix) configurations.

All GSM (Unix) configurations for diskette, QIC tape and DAT tape distribution have been replaced by a series of configurations for distribution on CD. The following tables explain the changes:

- Note-1 These versions of GSM (Unix) are no longer available. The support policy for these versions of Unix is described in section 3.0.4d of the Global Reseller Handbook Issue 19.
- Note-2 GSM (Unix) for SCO Unix is now only available on a Windows format CD (see table 2). All versions of SCO Unix from V3.2.2 to Open Server 5 are supported. The support policy for this version of Unix is described in section 3.0.4f of the Global Reseller Handbook Issue 19.
- Note-3 GSM (Unix) for AIX V3.2.5 is now only available on a Windows format CD (see table 2). V3.2.5 is the only version of AIX version 3 that is supported. The support policy for this version of Unix is described in section 3.0.4f of the Global Reseller Handbook Issue 19.
- Note-4 GSM (Unix) for HP-UX V11.0 is now only available on a Windows format CD (see table 2). HP-UX V11.0 is the only version of HP-UX that is supported. The support policy for this version of Unix is described in section 3.0.4f of the Global Reseller Handbook Issue 19.
- Note-5 GSM (Unix) for AIX V4.3 is now only available on a Windows format CD (see table 2). AIX V4.3 is the only version of AIX V4.n that is supported. The support policy for this version of Unix is described in section 3.0.4f of the Global Reseller Handbook Issue 19.

Technical Note IN280 and the appropriate Configuration Notes, all of which are distributed on the CD, fully explain the various technical details.

All the GSM (Unix) BACNAT variants distributed via CD, and listed in table 2, support both dual 16-bit/32-bit operation and the interface to the Global Application Explorer (GX). That is, **32-bit applications and GX are now supported on the following variations of GSM (Unix):**

SCO Unix	GX supported by BACNAT variant 3.311, and later
HP-UX V11.0	GX supported by BACNAT variant 3.312, and later
AIX V4.3	GX supported by BACNAT variant 3.310, and later
AIX V3.2.5	GX supported by BACNAT variant 3.313, and later
