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Making Tax Digital Service Packs

As a certified developer we regularly receive Fraud Prevention Header Status Reports from HMRC. These reports indicate that in a small percentage of the submissions generated by Global 3000, the fraud prevention headers do not meet the requirements of the current HMRC fraud prevention header specification. Note that the fraud prevention headers are required by law.

Service pack ZM60_000561 was released on 25-Feb-2020 to ensure that all submissions generated by Global 3000 conform to the current HMRC fraud prevention header specification.

Although end-users are currently not informed of any issues with the fraud prevention headers this will not always be the situation when HMRC make valid fraud prevention headers a compulsory requirement for Making Tax Digital submissions.

Please ensure all Global 3000 service packs, including ZM60_000561, are applied at all customers. **Failure to do so could result in HMRC rejecting submissions.**
